Award: The Historic Aiken Preservation Award

Honorees: Southern Bank & Trust, Laurens St.

Description: Presented to an individual for a restored or preserved commercial or public building.

Award: The Wilde-Lipe Treasured Home Award

Honorees: Tranquility Cottage, 424 Barnwell Ave. & The Clark House, 305 Colleton Ave.

Description: The award is presented to two persons who have restored residences. Improvements to the interior of the residences are not considered. One award is given for a small structure under 2500 square feet and one award is given for a large structure over 2500 square feet.

Award: Historic Aiken Adaptive Use Award

Honorees: Sugar Magnolia Cafe, Richland Ave.

Description: This award is given in recognition of adaptive use of a historic building or home which adds value to the Aiken community.

Award: Historic Aiken President's Award

Honoree: WESPAR Cottage, 208 Barnwell Ave. NE & Londo's Rehab., 330 Union St. NE

Description: The award is given in recognition of outstanding rehabilitation of a historic building destined for demolition.

Award: Historic Aiken Leadership Award

Honoree: William and Susan Reynold's Cottage, 1035 South Boundary Ave.

Description: This award is given in recognition of outstanding infill design for new construction that is compatible with new structures in the immediate area.

Historic Aiken Stewardship Award

Honoree: Aiken County Historical Museum

Description: A Stewardship Award given in recognition of outstanding upkeep of a key historic property in Aiken.
