**Award: The Historic Aiken Preservation Award**

Description: Presented to an individual for a restored or preserved commercial or public building.

**Honorees:** Abbey Lee Farmer & Michael D. Rubin for “The Stable on the Woods” - 2200 Dibble Rd.

**Award: The Wilde-Lipe Treasured Home Award**

Description: The award is presented to two persons who have restored residences. Improvements to the interior of the residences are not considered. One award is given for a small structure under 2500 square feet and one award is given for a large structure over 2500 square feet.
